Pennsylvania School Law 1304-A

Prior to admission to any school, the parent, or guardian, or other person having control or charge of a student, shall upon registration, provide a sworn statement or affirmation stating whether the pupil was previously suspended or expelled from any public or private school of the Commonwealth or any other State for an act or offense involving weapons, alcohol, or drugs, or for the willful infliction of injury to another person or for any act of violence committed on school property, at a school sponsored activity or on a public or private conveyance providing transportation to or from school or a school sponsored activity.
